How many?



If you have children under 5 (below school age) you are welcome to drop in any Friday between 9.30am and 11.30am for Stay & Play. This is an open session with a variety of activities for little ones, plus snacks to keep their energy up (and yours of course).

Kids Club runs on Friday afternoons, 4.30pm to 6pm during term time, for any children in Primary School. This is an hour and half filled with games, Bible story, craft, plus drinks and snacks.

How to listen as you read

God wants to speak to you. This simple truth can change how you read your Bible. It is not a book to be read, rather, here are words from God, words that the Holy Spirit is wanting to underline for you, whisper into your soul, words that will touch your life.

How do you Listen?

First, invite God to speak to you. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you ears to hear and eyes to see, that He will speak to you as you read.

Then read.

What did you notice? Is there a sentence, a phrase, a word, that caught your attention?

Then listen.

Take a notepad and write down the verse or phrase. Add to that what it was about those words that caught your attention.

Now reflect—listen some more.

Write down what this might mean for you. Not just an abstract truth, but how this speaks to your life, how you will live today.

What is God saying to you?

Go back and read what you have written down. Is there anything you want to add to this, or any more insights or thoughts you can add?

Now thank Him.

Take a moment and give thanks to God for what you have seen, for what He has spoken to you today.

Now go and live it out.
