## The One you love

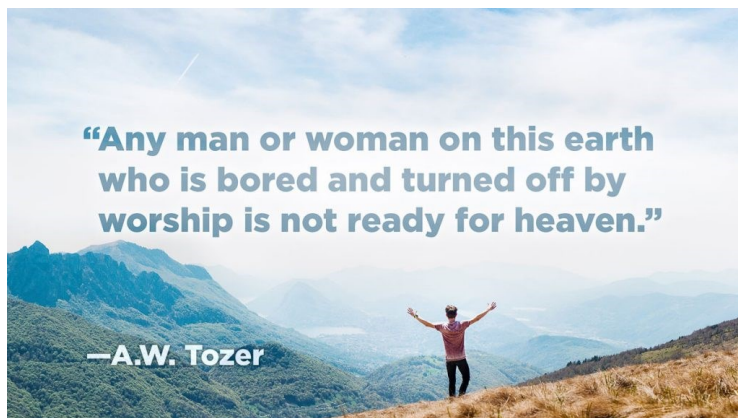
Psalm 96 gives us a great example of worship: words that tell of God's goodness and greatness.

John reminds us that Jesus told us what type of worship is acceptable and pleasing to God (John 4:23).

We know that worship is more than words, it is something that comes from our heart, from our soul, from our very being. We sometimes talk about love as worship: when someone is totally captivated and devoted to the one they love they can be described as "worshipping them".

Worship comes from our hearts, is expressed to God in words, through music, and in how we live out our daily lives: we are centred in and around God.

Worship is the language of the Kingdom of God and the practice of heaven. As we gaze on God in worship, so we encounter new realities of God's presence. Why? Because God is enthroned (His presence is found) in the praise of His people (Psalm 22:3)
